DEMOLITION DERBY RULES & REGULATIONS:

The Demolition Derby is open to all drivers (men and women) who hold a valid driver's license. The following rules and regulations apply to the Demolition Derby:

1. Race day is Saturday, July 18, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. at the Beaverhead County Fairgrounds in Dillon, Montana.
2. Demolition cars must be at the fairgrounds two (2) hours before the race (3:00 p.m.) or earlier preferred.
3. Car inspections start at 12:00 p.m. at designated inspection area and will not be allowed to leave after inspection. Cars participating in the parade at 3:00 p.m. will be inspected immediately following the parade.

DRIVER ENTRY:

1. Driver must be 18 years of age, or have a notarized permit from parents or guardian.
2. Driver must furnish his/her own car OR have someone support his/her car.
3. American built sedans or station wagons allowed. NO jeeps, trucks, SUV's, convertibles.
4. Driver may enter each heat BUT must have DIFFERENT car for each heat.
5. Driver eligible for main event may purchase one of the cars that did not qualify as long as it competed in one of the heats.
6. Herbie Derby cars are not eligible for the main event.
7. Driver may use a maximum of 2 pit men per car.
8. Entries will be accepted up to two (2) hours prior to race time (3:00 pm).
9. Driver must sign entry blank and release form prior to derby.

ENTRY FEE:

1. The car with driver entered shall pay \$45 in advance or \$50 day of derby at the gate for main event and \$40 and \$45 for Herbie and Powder Puff which includes the driver and his 2 pit men.
2. All drivers and pit men must sign the responsibility release form prior to the derby.

HEAT & MAIN EVENT:

1. The total number of autos entered in derby will be divided into heats. Cars will be placed in heats at the drivers meeting.
2. The last three cars active from each heat will advance to the main event.
3. There will be a consolation heat for all cars that didn't make it to the main event after all heats have run. Top three finishers will advance to the main event in consolation heat.

REMOVAL OF CARS:

1. Each driver MUST remove his car from the fairgrounds immediately after the performance.
2. Any driver that does not remove his/her car within 24 hours will be fined \$100 for the removal fee..

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS:

1. Back of seat must be chained to roof or have door to door brace against back of seat and a vertical brace from roof to floor directly behind the drivers seat. Dash braces and door to door braces are allowed, **ONLY DOOR TO DOOR -NOT DOOR TO FLOOR**, no less than 2" minimum & 4" max. in diameter round or square, with a minimum of 4"x4" or max. 12"x12" plate on each end. Door to door brace must be 3" or less from the back of the drivers seat. You are allowed to put a brace no more then 4" diameter from the dash brace to the door to door brace. No more then 5" away from the inside of the passenger door.
2. Driver may maneuver forward and backward (first and reverse gears only).
3. **NO hitting opponent's car in driver's door.**
4. If a driver does not hit another car within one minute, that driver will be disqualified.
5. Driver must remain in the car until the heat is over and with the car until it is removed from the arena. Any driver that leaves his/her car before the heat is stopped will immediately disqualified from the derby.
6. All drivers and pit men must attend the pit meeting prior to the derby.
7. Following the pit meeting, any questions concerning the derby may be brought forth by **DRIVERS ONLY**. **Harassment of the help by the drivers or pit men, etc., will not be tolerated and will be cause for disqualification.** The behavior of the pit men will be the responsibility of the DRIVER.
8. Judge's decisions are final on winners and disqualifications.
9. As soon as the first heat is on the track, the second heat cars must line up at the gate, and so on. Cars not lined up immediately will not get into the heat. This is the responsibility of the DRIVER & the pit crew.
10. Cars qualifying for the main event must line up immediately after their individual heat. Cars not in position following the next heat will be scratched from the main event roster. A reasonable amount of time will be allowed for the last heat cars to prepare for the main event.
11. No driver or pit man will be allowed to participate while under the influence of drugs or alcohol. **NO ALCOHOL WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA.**
12. Only the Driver and the Pit Crew in the pit area after 4:00 pm.
13. No pit man will be allowed in the arena during the heat or main event.
14. Cars that don't qualify for the main event will be allowed to work on their cars immediately in order to prepare for the consolation round.

PREPARATION OF CARS:

1. Slogans, advertising or printing may be placed on the car except for an 18" x 18" space on both front doors for your numbers. If you want your number reserved please call in advance.
2. **ALL GLASS, EXTERIOR CHROME, WHEEL WEIGHTS, PLASTIC INNER FENDERS, FAN SCHROUELS, POT METAL, ETC. MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE** reaching the fairgrounds.
3. Fuel tanks must be placed in back seat area and must be removed from stock location. Fuel tanks must be fastened and secured **NO BUNGE STRAPS**. Batteries maybe located in cab area, must also be secured **NO BUNGE STRAPS**.
4. Radiators and fans may be removed but not relocated. Bumpers and fenders may be cut/trimmed. **DRIVER'S DOOR MUST BE WELDED** to the body **AND** reinforced, not exceeding 6" past door seam. **NO GRADER BLADE** - Use 3" angle iron and trim corners. Weld angle on both top and bottom. Do not bolt.
5. Hood **MUST NOT** be welded shut or **CANNOT** be bolted prior to inspection.
6. Windshield opening must have a minimum of one (1) vertical support (we suggest in the center) to prevent hood from coming through.
7. **NO** special bumpers, extra weight, trailer hitches, air lift shocks, coil over shocks, blocks, shackle, **or any other reinforcements.**
8. All doors must be welded or chained, or they will be disqualified.
9. Seat belts and helmets are required. Seat belts will be anchored to the floor, behind the driver's seat. (Seat Belts Only)
10. All vehicles will be inspected at the designated inspection area before entering the pit area. It is drivers responsibility to bring car back to inspection area after fixing any infractions.
11. All cars will be inspected again before race time. The inspector's decision is final.
12. Tires are to be filled with air only. (No wheel weights) No studs.
13. Wheel size is not to exceed 15". **NO PADDLE TIRES.**
14. Dash braces, door to door braces and a verticle brace from roof to floor directly behind the drivers seat are allowed, **ONLY DOOR TO DOOR -NOT DOOR TO FLOOR**, no less than 2" minimum and 4" max in diameter round or square, with a minimum of 4"x4" or max. 12"x12" plate on each end. Door to door brace must be 3" or less from the back of the drivers seat. You are allowed to put a brace no more then 4" diameter from the dash brace to the door to door brace. No more then 5" away from the inside of the passenger door.
15. External Transmission coolers are allowed. They must be bolted or chained down and located in cab area. Judges will inspect coolers and lines for safety purposes. **NO** rubber hose or fuel line. Use only steel line or transmission cooler hose (**NO FUEL HOSE**).
